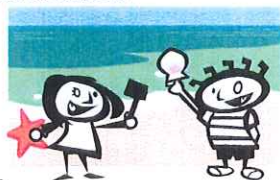
The Snowball Club recognises that parents working hours and busy lifestyles do not often coincide with the conventional school day. Children enjoy being with other children and thrive in their company and so parents are looking for a safe place where the needs of their children can be met. In response to this, the Snowball Club offer a range of services for children between the ages of 3 and 11 years.

Breakfast Club

Operating during term time, breakfast is served giving children a healthy choice of cereal, toast and fruit juice before being taken to school by supervised escort. There is a range of appropriate, quiet activities to ease them gently into the day.

After School Club

Children are collected from school by supervised escort. A full range of activities is available, for example, table-football, games, arts and crafts, play station, as well as outdoor play facilities. For added interest themed activities and special events are scheduled regularly. Healthy snacks and drinks are provided for the children.



Holiday Club

Operating during all school holidays, activities focus on giving children the opportunity of participating in a variety of exciting programmes. Examples include creative workshops, games, sports, ceramics, art, cookery, visits and outings. To maximise choice, a range of other activities are available at all other times, such as, arts and crafts, computer, dance mat, board games and outdoor games.

The Snowball Out of School Club operates at Chapel-en-le-Frith Primary School for children aged 3 to 11 years. We provide childcare for children who attend Chapel Primary School or live in the catchment area, aged 3 to 11 years.

When places are limited children will be admitted in the following order of preference:

- Children who attend Chapel-en-le-Frith Primary School
- Siblings of children already attending
- Children of parents who work or are attending as volunteers (including children of Club employees who need childcare to work at the Club)
- First come, first served from the waiting list
